ELECTION AND NOMINATION RULES AND PROCEDURES - 2019

All applicants and candidates, including prospective House Captains and Vice Captains in addition to applicants for nominated positions (ie: Society Representatives and Vice Representatives) the **Student Council Application Form** can be collected from the Student Affairs Office from Monday 21st January or printed at home (it will be uploaded on Facebook Batch of 2020 and 2022 pages)

The application form must be submitted latest by **Wednesday, 30th January** by **2.15pm** in the **Deposit Boxes** which will be placed in Mrs. Tariq's office for A'level applicants, and in Mrs. Kamal's office for O'level applicants. 1. You are **NOT** allowed to apply for more than one nominated position.
2. From **Monday, 4th February to Wednesday 6th February** teachers in charge of each Society will interview short-listed applicants.
3. From **Thursday, 7th February to Friday, 8th February**, Mrs. Shah may interview applicants who have been **further short listed**. A detailed schedule of these interviews will appear on the official Batch pages.
4. Mrs. Shah will announce position holders on **Monday, 11th February in long break**.
5. Applications for House Captain and Vice Captain must be submitted latest by **Tuesday, 12th February to your house teachers**. *Please note that if you did not attain a nominated position, you may apply for House Captain or Vice Captain.*

4. Campaigning will take place on **Tuesday, 19th February and Wednesday, 20th February**.

Anyone found campaigning before these dates will be disqualified.

5. Elections will be held on **Thursday, 21st February** in long break and results will announced in the fifth lesson on the same day.
6. Students from classes 7 to 11 are eligible to vote for Vice- Captains.
7. Students from classes 11 to A2 are eligible to vote for Captains.
8. The **Oath Taking and Award Ceremony** will take place on **Monday, 25th February, 2018 at 7:30 AM.**
