## **EVENT POLICY**

# **Dress Code**

Students representing LGS 55 Main at inter/intra school events are required to follow the dress code specified below.

- 1. O Level students must wear the school uniform at all times during the event. They are not permitted to wear any make-up or jewelry. In summer, students must be in a clean, pressed white shalwar kameez with a clean, neatly pinned sash, and polished white joggers. In winter, the blue checked shalwar kameez should be worn with the navy-blue sash, school sweater or school fleece jacket, and white polished joggers. Their hair must be tied back neatly with a black hair tie.
- 2. A Level Students have the following options;
  - **a)** White trousers/shalwar and white kameez/kurta with a dupatta of their choice
  - **b)** Navy blue trousers, navy blue blazer, plain white shirt and formal shoes (flats or pumps- heel no higher than an inch/inch and a half)

When it is determined that a student's clothing does not comply with the dress code, a parent/guardian may be asked to bring an appropriate change of clothes to school or the student may be stopped from going to the event. The Principal may decide to permit exceptions to this policy for certain extracurricular activities that require a particular dress/outfit to be worn.

#### Behaviour

Students are expected to always practice good manners. They should greet their hosts and thank them when they leave the event. They should conduct themselves in a polite and respectful manner throughout the event. Should an issue arise, they should contact their Student Council Teacher in charge and lodge a complaint with her so the matter can be dealt with at an official level.

### **Social Events**

Attending socials, which are often part of intra school events, is entirely **optional.** Parents can collect their child/children from the event before the social if they wish to do so. **The school does not provide a chaperone or supervision at these social events.** 

This policy applies to all students attending school events or school sponsored events. Violation of this policy will be treated as contravention of school rules/policies and will result in a disciplinary action.
