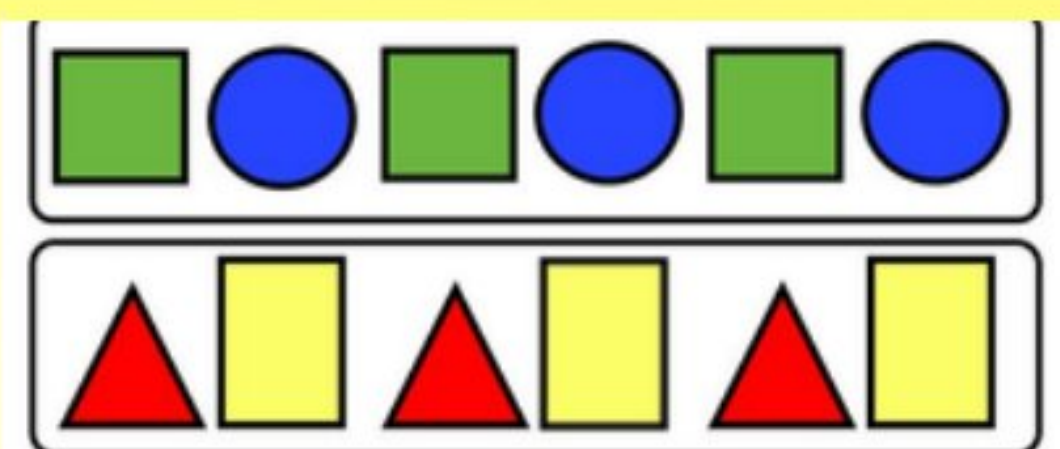


# Learning areas covered in the second term

# New Class, New Beginnings



**Dear Parents,**

Playgroup was a big step in your child's life and your life as a parent. Transition times are learning times for our children and us. Remember that becoming comfortable in a new classroom is an ongoing process, not just a single event.

As the first day for transition draws near, begin talking to your child about what to expect and about any concerns or fears they might have. The more you prepare your child for his/her first day in Nursery, the better adjusted your child will be in the new class. Set up a routine for your child's sleeping and eating schedule slowly. This may help smooth the transition.

Here are a few suggestions of things you can do to help them develop well-rounded personalities:

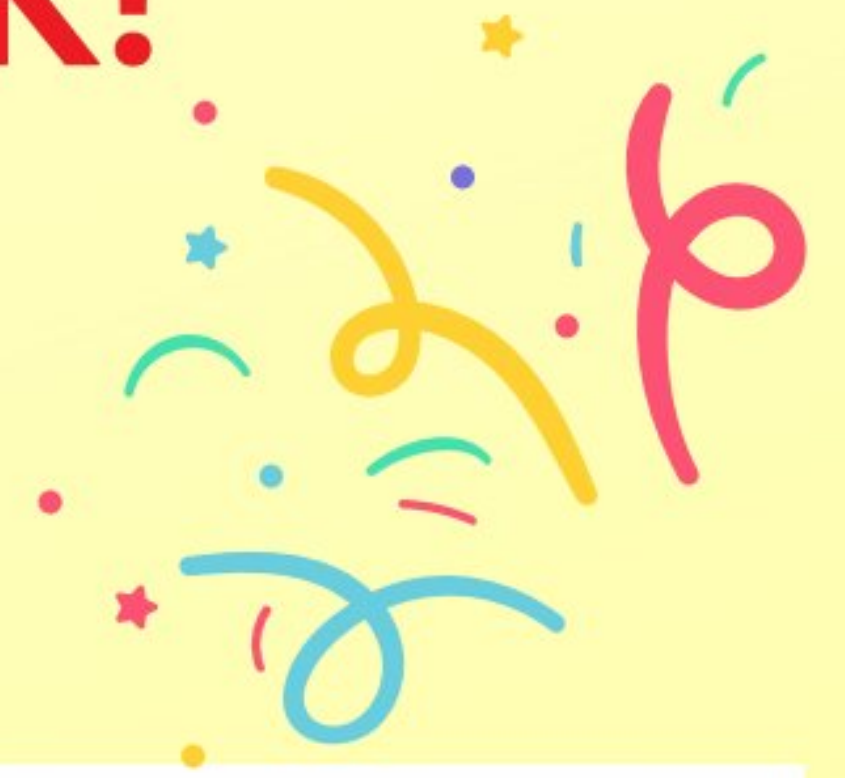
- Read to your child and encourage him/her to recall the main events and characters of the story. This will improve their ability to maintain focus.
- Engage them in activities that enhance eye-hand coordination e.g. fixing puzzles, building towers with blocks, sorting lentils, etc.
- Build self-help skills by allowing your child to put on his/her clothes, tidying up and putting things back in their proper place, eating themselves and washing their hands afterwards.
- Encourage your child to carry out small tasks at home, e.g. helping in clearing up the table after a meal, putting their shoes back in the shoe rack and clearing up the room after playtime.
- Provide the opportunity to play out-door to explore the environment to enhance their observation and problem-solving skills.
- Limit screen time (TV, computers, laptop, and iPads).
